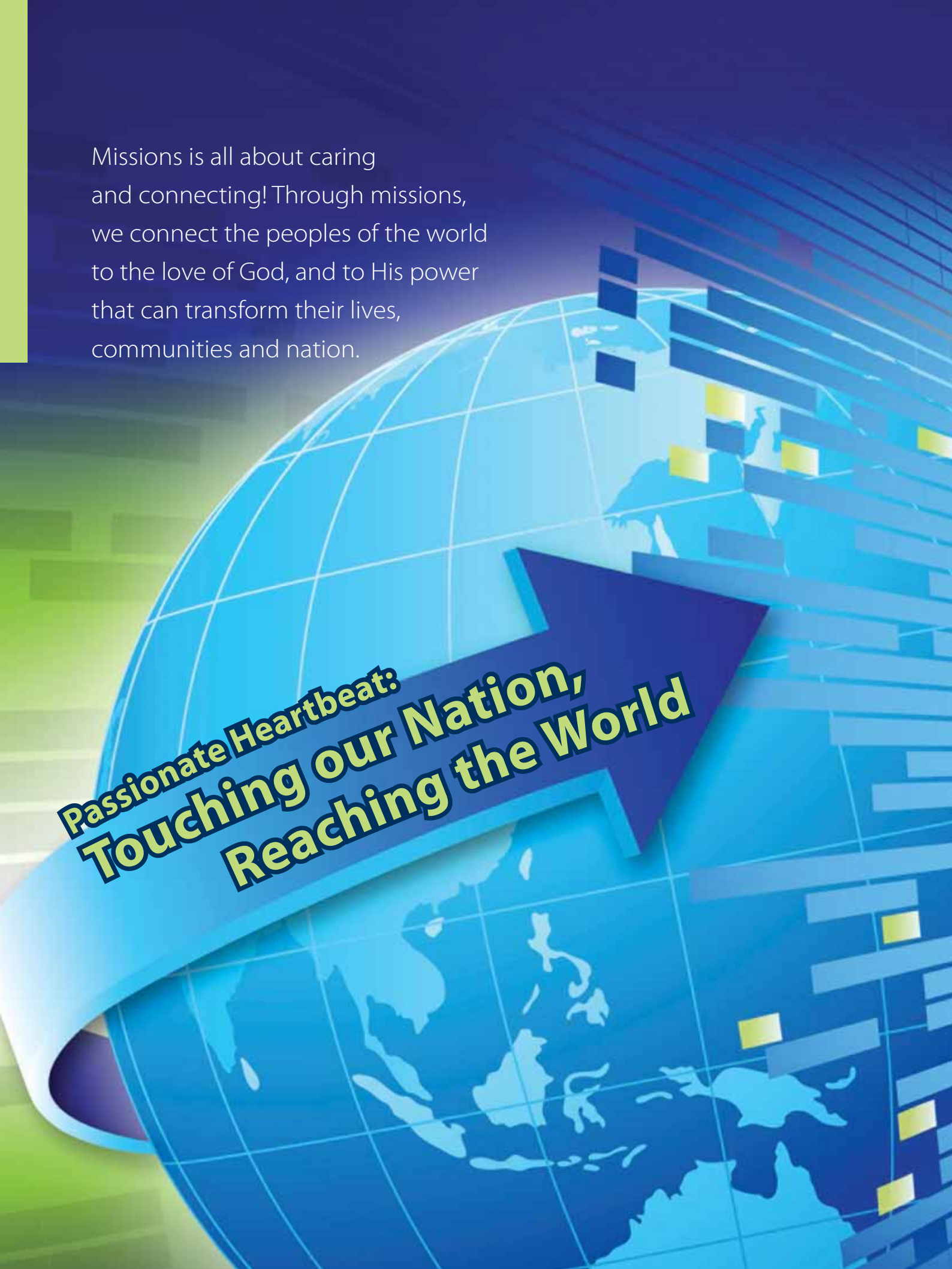

Humanitarian Missions

Jesus has given us the mandate to take care of the widows and orphans, the needy and underprivileged of society. Through humanitarian missions, Trinity cares for the desolate and destitute in poverty-stricken areas of the world. In 2007, we have:

Benevolent Fund

Trinity fulfills the biblical mandate to “care for the orphans and the widows ” by blessing needy individuals and families with financial assistance in the form of NTUC vouchers, school pocket money and EZ-link cards.

Care Community Services Society

CCSS impacts society by bringing wholeness and restoring hope to a wide spectrum of people, including children, youth and the elderly. In 2007, CCSS influenced and equipped more than 2500 counselling clients and over 1600 prison inmates.

Thought for the Day radio broadcast

Every weekday, Trinity’s radio programme provides a God perspective and opens the door for listeners to encounter God wherever they are. Through this programme, listeners have been greatly blessed, and have written in to share their testimonies with us.

Missions Impact Trips

Our Missions Impact Trips provide Trinitarians with the opportunity to impact the nations. Through these trips, Trinitarians have touched and transformed lives in various cultures and nations.

Training and consultation on the Carecell Model

We share the Carecell Model with pastors and leaders around the world to bring fresh vision into their lives and ministry. The training and church

consultation empowers them to expand the leadership base of their church, to disciple believers and to reach the lost through a Care & Connect movement called carecells.

Prophetic Training

We train pastors and leaders to hear from God so that they can be God’s prophetic voice in their church. As they hear and obey God, they learn to move in the power of God, strengthening their church.

Naomi Dowdy Ministries

Trinity’s missions programme also supports the international ministry of Rev Dr Naomi Dowdy. She mentors strategic ministry leaders, enabling them to fulfill God’s purpose in their own nation and on the international scene.
